



Magicians from Crailsheim, winners of the U15 tournament

HAKRO Merlins Crailsheim win the second tournament in the U15 category, although it was not without hesitation. Other medal positions were occupied by teams from the Czech Republic, namely Jižní Supi and Vlci Žďár nad Sázavou.

Crailsheim played two games on Friday, the first against Kraków, where they recorded a comfortable win. The second with the wolves from Ždár nad Sázavou, who tried to turn the game around in the last quarter, but failed.

On Saturday, the players of the home team probably got out of bed with the left foot, because during the entire match with Oberpfalz Hunters they did not manage to get into the game at all, especially Justus Reintjes, who burdened their account with 31 points, was a problem.

On Sunday, an imaginary final could take place with the Jížní Supi team, which had a record of 4-0 before this match. The first half was very balanced, as evidenced by the halftime score of 30:31 for the team from Prague. After the third quarter, the Jížní Supi team already led by a difference of 9 points and it looked like they were on their way to winning the tournament. However, the home team turned on turbo mode in the last quarter and eventually took the win by 5 points and thus the victory in the tournament.

The other teams also alternated stronger and weaker moments, which eventually led to each team taking home at least one win. This will certainly support them in further work in training.
