



PGE Spójnia Stargard wins the U14 tournament

Stargard wins the thirteenth U14 tournament hosted by Jelenia Góra. No team in this tournament put up much resistance to the winner, allowing him to fully utilize his entire rotation.

The tournament started with a duel between the home team and Beksa from Pardubice. Beksa was losing from the start and NBA had a fairly comfortable path to its first victory. The second match was played by Korona 1919 Krakow, who replaced the absent Handlová, and their opponent was a team from South Bohemia, Sršni Písek. The Hornets inflicted 115 stings on Krakow, and the Polish team found no answer to that and lost by a significant margin. NBA Jelenia Góra after a short rest, challenged the German team Thuringia Select Team and the match was extremely interesting. The German team started better, winning the first quarter. In the second quarter, the lead changed in favor of the home team and despite the great onslaught of the German team, they maintained their lead until the final horn. The last team to get involved was PGE Spójnia Stargard, who definitely did not spare Krakow and awarded it 147 points.

On Saturday, Beksa from Pardubice was in the lead, losing to Thuringií after a good start to the game. In the second game, they got their taste and took a win over Krakow in a start-finish style. The second team that tried to mix up the standings was also from the Czech Republic. The Hornets first showed a great performance against Stargard, when in the first half they were a balanced opponent, in the second half the quality of the Polish team was already evident and they won. The Hornets did not give their skin cheaply even in the duel with the German team Thuringia. Here they had a worse start to the game, but gradually the Hornets' stingers find their target and several times come close to a difference of only one basket in the score. In the end, however, their strength is not enough and in a limited rotation they lose the game.

On Sunday, the last match between the home team and Sršni Písek was no less interesting. A match that offered everything we can expect from basketball. Fighting spirit, twists and turns, successful shots in the last second, emotions, great performances by the players. The Hornets are already in a very tight rotation, resisting the enthusiasm of the home team, who want to win silver medals at the tournament. The match began with a real shooting explosion, what else can you call it, when a total of 56 points are scored in a quarter. The Hornets fight hard and even though they are resilient "animals", they are still a small step behind. In the end, they get a home victory and Sršni is left with an unpopular fourth place.
