



Science City Jena wins the U15 tournament

The tenth tournament of the U15 category took place in the Polish city of Ostrów Wielkopolski. After an interesting tournament, the German team Science City Jena won the gold medals.

In the first match, the home team AK Stal Ostrów Wielkopolski gave no chance to think about winning to the other home team, composed of younger players from the same club. The next Polish match was also quite clear, when WKS Slask Wroclaw team did not mess with the newcomer in our tournaments Kosz Ciepłomax Kompaktowy Pleszew . In the last match of the first round, the Czech team Sokol Pražský played a solid game with the later winner of the Science City Jena, na výhru to však nestačilo.

On Saturday, the program began with an imaginary duel for first place between the home team and Jena. The German team gradually blunted the home team's attacks and drives, and with German patience and precision, built a lead in the score, which eventually grew to fourteen points. A very good match was played by the Sokol Pražský team against the Polish team WKS Slask Wroclaw . The Czech team led by a double-digit margin almost throughout the match and only at the end of the match did Slask allow a slight correction of the score. Sokol Pražský thus began to "sneak" at the medal positions. Slask was also close to the younger home team, where in the end they finally defended the victory by three points.

However, things happen on Sunday. First, Jena loses significantly to Silesia. The German team apparently did not keep their curfew, how else can they explain such a collapse. It should be added that the German team could have afforded the loss thanks to a better mutual match with the first home team, winning gold medals. In the next match, the cards are dealt clearly, the Czech team Sokol Pražský must win the match against the younger home team to win the bronze medals. The Czech team leads by ten points before the last quarter, unfortunately it is very limited by the number of personal mistakes of the players and finally loses by two points at the end of the match. This leaves it with only fifth place in the tournament, the younger home team with fourth place and Silesia "falls into its lap" with the bronze. In the last match of the tournament, the home team confirms its silver medal win by winning the match against the Polish team Kosz Ciepłomax Kompaktowy Pleszew .
