



Zielona Góra leads the triumph from Nymburk

The third tournament in the U14 category was hosted by Nymburk, the last winner from Poland. Now the roles have reversed and the gold goes to Poland, specifically to Zielona Góra, which did not find a winner in the tournament.

The Polish team SKM Zastal Zielona Góra participated in their first tournament this year and it was an excellent debut, as they won all 5 matches and deservedly took the gold. But they definitely didn't have it easy, after all three matches ended with a difference of less than 7 points.

The second place belongs to the tigers from České Budějovice, who were not enough to win the tournament.

ŠBK Handlová takes home the second bronze, which after Wrocław also takes third place in Nymburk.

The unpopular fourth place goes to Germany for the Mitteldeutsche Basketball Academy team, who, however, have now improved by one position after the 5th place from Děčín.

Host Nymburk, which did not have the best form at the home tournament, finished in fifth place.

Even on the second attempt, the players of the Jižní Supi team did not get their first win in the competition, so they were left with the last place.
