



Kangoo Basket is the winner of the U13 tournament in Ústí

The opening tournament of the U13 category in Ústí nad Orlicí was dominated by the players of the Polish team Kangoo Basket Gorzów Wielkopolski, who did not find a conqueror in the tournament and deservedly took first place.

The Kangoo Basket players, who won 3 matches without any major difficulties, reached the overall triumph without significant difficulties. Only Sokol Dubeč was able to keep pace with them for the entire match, and the home team BA Young Diamonds for three quarters as well.

In the other positions, it was already fairly even, as evidenced by the final balance sheet. Two teams were 3-2 and the other two were 2-3. Matches between each other decided the ranking.

The winning of silver and bronze was decided in the last match on Saturday between BBA Komárno and Sokol Dubeč. After a big drama, the Slovak team, led mainly by the best scorer of the tournament, Slugeň, rejoiced in the end.

The ranking just below the podium was determined only by the final match of the tournament, in which the home academy dealt with JBN boys and thus took fourth place ahead of their Czech opponent.

In the end, the second Slovakian team ŠBK Handlová finished without a victory.
