



Stargard the clear winner of the U17 tournament

PGE Spójnia Stargard became the winner of the second tournament in the U17 category. The Stargard players surpassed all their opponents with their team concept and deservedly took home the gold medals from the tournament in Frýdek-Místek.

The tournament program started with a match between the home team from Frýdek-Místek and the Science City Jena team. Basketpoint was pulling the short end of the rope for most of the game. However, in the last quarter, he took a breather for the onslaught, which he crowned with the winning shot in the last seconds of the game. The second interesting match in Friday's program offered a duel between "Beksa" (BK VIVIDBOOKS Pardubice), which started in this tournament as a guest outside the overall ranking, and PGE Spójnia Stargard . Beksa kept pace for three quarters of the game, when after the third quarter the score difference was only single digits, then Stargard confirmed its quality and wide rotation of players and dominated the game with a difference of 27 points. Later it turned out that this match decided the first and second place in the tournament.

Saturday's program was a rest day for Stargard himself, where he gifted AK Stal Ostrów Wielkopolski a BK Lokomotíva Sereď with more than 100 points. An interesting menu was offered by Beksy's match, first against the home Basketpoint, where the win was not as easy as the final score suggests, and especially against the German team Science City Jena . Here, extra time brought resolution, where Beks took the victory with the difference of a single three-point shot. Certainly a very interesting spectacle for the audience.

Sunday's program offered a comfortable win for Stargard over Jena. Subsequently, Beksa decided to gamble with her position in the table, when she enjoyed a twenty-point cushion after three quarters, only to defend the victory by just three points in the end. The program of the tournament was closed by the home team from Frýdek-Místek, which packed more than fifty points on the team from Sereď on the way home.

The interesting thing about the tournament is that seven players of the Stargard team maintained an average of more than ten points per game, and the other two are close to it. Great team play and promotion of basketball.
