



BCM Olomouc wins the U15 tournament without hesitation

Olomouc organized the fourteenth tournament in the U15 category at home. None of the teams came even close to scoring twenty points against Olomouc. So winning the gold medals was quite a comfortable affair for the home team.

The tournament had an unusual draw, thanks to which the teams joined the tournament gradually. The home team was initially challenged by the Polish team Górnik Airteam Walbrzych . Olomouc created a twenty-point lead in the first quarter and easily dominated the match. The second match between the Slovak team Slávia Trnava and AK Stal Ostrów Wielkopolski offered a dramatic course. Trnava led by a comfortable margin for three quarters, but Stal made an unprecedented turnaround in the last quarter and won by a margin of seven points. The first German team NINERS Chemnitz Academy participated in the third match of the day in a duel with the home team. Olomouc won by a significant margin. The last participant of the tournament Mitteldeutscher Basketball Academy also participated in the last match of Friday's program. They beat Trnava calmly, by a margin of more than twenty points.

Saturday offered two close games. The first was between MBA and Walbrzych. MBA still had a nine-point lead after the third quarter, only to lose by a single point in the final. The second game was played again by Walbrzych, and the opponent was Trnava, which entered the game actively, built a lead in the first quarter, which it gradually lost and eventually lost by a four-point difference. Walbrzych won the silver medals thanks to the victory in these two close games.

Sunday brought no major dramas and the medal favorites confirmed their position.
