



SKM Zastal Zielona Góra wins the U14 tournament

The eleventh tournament of the U14 category took place in Brandýs nad Labem. The Polish team SKM Zastal Zielona Góra showed the best performance and won gold medals. Other medal places are also occupied by Polish teams. So Polish teams versus the rest of the world 3:0.

In the first match of the tournament, the Czech team Fastav Zlín was not enough for the eventual winner SKM Zastal Zielona Góra. The second Czech team Start Havířov was no match for the German team Academy Potsdam and suffered a heavy defeat. The third match was played under Polish control, when Gromy Nowy Tomyśl team showed no mercy to the KS Korona 1919 RadwanSport Kraków team. Later it turned out that this match was a match for the silver medals.

On Saturday, a balanced match started the day's program. The match between Krakow and Zlín was very balanced, but the Polish team was always ahead by a few points. In the end, the Polish team won by eight points. The other matches of the day ended with higher point differences.

On Sunday, Krakow had no problem overcoming Potsdam's resistance to confirm the bronze medal, and everything was actually decided in the first quarter. The second match of the day was a duel for gold medals between the Polish teams SKM Zastal Zielona Góra and Gromy Nowy Tomyśl. The latter team entered the match actively and gained a small lead, but seemed to be gradually losing its breath as it gradually lost its lead. Zastal took a slight lead in the middle of the match, which it subsequently increased in the third quarter. In the last quarter, Zastal maintained its lead and thus won the gold medals, while Tomyśl remains with the silver medals. In the last match of the tournament, the Czech teams from Zlín and Havířov meet. And you could say that the miners are quite successful in defeating the shoemakers, as they win by twelve points.
