



WKK Wrocław wins the U17 tournament

The tenth edition of the U17 tournament took place in the Polish city of Wrocław. The home team deservedly won gold medals, thanks to the fact that they scored an average of more than 100 points per game against all their opponents.

In the opening match of the tournament, the home team WKK Wrocław encountered the greatest resistance from the opponent in this tournament, which was the Polish team Weegree AZS Opole . However, WKK wins this match by about thirty points. In the second match, the Czech team BK Sojky Pelhřimov played an even game with the Polish team SKM Zastal Zielona Góra . The match is really decided by little things, minor mistakes, and in the end, the Polish team wins it. In the next match, the Slovak team BKM Iskra Svit enters the tournament, which will measure its strength with the German team SC Weende . Iskra did not enter the match in the best possible way, but from the second quarter it takes the initiative and finally wins a comfortable victory. And Iskra once again. In the last match of the day, it played a dramatic match with Zastal, which, however, loses in the final by a difference of only one basket.

Saturday hardly brings surprising results and most matches end with a higher point difference in the score. The only "bright" exception is the match between SC Weende and SKM Zastal Zielona Góra . The table clearly indicates who is the favorite of the match. However, the opposite is true. The German team is clearly the better team from the middle of the match and gets a deserved win by almost twenty points. And this is what makes basketball so beautiful, when most of the time no assumptions are certain and the match always starts with a zero-zero score and it is only up to the participants how it will develop.

On Sunday, the program begins with the Sojky, who defeat the German team SC Weende . And only thanks to a better mutual match, they win fifth place in the tournament. In the second match, Iskra did not mature in Opole and, thanks to a worse mutual match with Zastal, they narrowly miss out on a medal. In the last match of the tournament, the home team, playing in euphoria, "outclassed" Zastal and confirmed the gold medal win.
