



Academy NH Ostrava wins the U14 tournament

The fifteenth tournament of the U14 category took place in the Czech city of Ostrava. And the home team used its environment perfectly and won the tournament. And with this, it also confirmed its progress to the final tournament with a score of 15:0.

In the opening match, the home team Academy NH Ostrava defeats the Polish team Imopeksis Wilki Wrocław. The tournament continues with a Czech-Slovak duel between the teams JBN boys and BK Inter Bratislava. While the Czech team dominated the first half of the match, the Slovak team was the more successful team in the second half of the match, winning by fourteen points. The third match between the Ukrainian team BC Uzhhorod and the German team Basketball Talents Potsdam was even more balanced. The Ukrainian team enters the match well. However, the German team counterattacks halfway through the match and takes the lead. However, it loses this in the second half of the match and eventually loses by a difference of ten points. Another fight closes the Friday program of the day. The duel between Inter and Uzhhorod is one of the highlights of the tournament. First, Inter takes the lead, halfway through the match Uzhhorod leads slightly, and when it "stretches" the lead to eleven points after the third quarter, it seems that it is heading for victory. The opposite is true. Inter fought hard in the final minutes and managed to squeeze out a win by just two points.

On Saturday, JBN put in a very solid performance against Uzhhorod, which was certainly the favorite in this match. However, in the end, they suffered a defeat by twelve points. The South Bohemian team improved their appetite in the afternoon program, when they defeated Wrocław by the same margin. Apparently, Inter likes to play dramatic endings. On Saturday, they were slightly behind in the score for three quarters, only to finally win by a single point in the end over Potsdam. The home team also apparently wanted to try an even ending and played against Uzhhorod. And since they managed it, they laid the foundation for the overall victory in the tournament. Uzhhorod was the only one to keep the score difference with Ostrava at a single digit. The other teams were not so "lucky" and Ostrava "burdened" them with high point allocations.

On Sunday, Potsdam defeats JBN. Only the first quarter was even and then the German team took the initiative and gave JBN more than a twenty-point gift on the way. Uzhhorod confirms the bronze medal thanks to a calm victory over Wrocław. Ostrava dominated the final of the tournament between the home team and Inter with a start-finish system and deservedly wins gold. Inter took home silver.
