



# Krakow also won its second U15 tournament

After a winning debut in Slovakia, the Korona 1919 Krakow club this time hosted the tournament in the U15 category on home turf. What did not change, however, was the final standings, when the home boys left this tournament as winners.

Before the tournament, we unfortunately had to deal with the absence of two originally nominated teams. In the end we solved the situation by having the home club field their second team made up of boys from the year 2008. Of course, this team played outside the competition, but it ensured that every team that traveled to Krakow could play 4 full games.

Regular participant Korona 1919 Krakow clearly had the upper hand in the duel with the Czech opponents, but in the race for first place with another Polish team WKS Slask Wroclaw there was great drama. In the end, the home team won this duel with a difference of 6 points, thus securing the first place in the tournament just ahead of the opponent with Wroclaw.

The second home team lost to both Polish teams and beat both Czech teams.

Královští Sokoli Hradec Králové and Basketpoint Frýdek-Místek played for a single victory on Saturday. The boys from Hradec Králové finally succeeded, mainly thanks to a successful final quarter.
