



Academy Potsdam wins U13 tournament

The ninth tournament of the U13 category took place in the Polish city of Szczawno Zdrój. The clear winner of this tournament was the German team Academy Potsdam.

In the first match of the tournament, the home team MKS Basket Szczawno Zdrój easily dealt with another Polish team WKK Wrocław. The Czech derby between Basketpoint Frýdek-Místek and Válečníci Děčín was also quite clear in favor of the Moravian team. The third match also brought no dramas, as the German team Academy Potsdam easily defeated the Slovak team BSC Bratislava.

On Saturday, Válečníci Děčín will play a balanced match. First, it is a defensive duel with WKK, when they are losing at first, but after the third quarter the score is almost even. In the end, however, the Polish team WKK "scrams" to victory. In the second match with BSC, more attractive basketball is played, but here too the Czech team fails to win. The day closes with a duel for first place between the home team and Potsdam. Potsdam keeps the home team at a fairly solid distance in the score for three quarters. In the last quarter, the home team tried to defy fate, but the well-playing Potsdam does not allow it to make more than a slight correction to the score.

On Sunday, Basketpoint calmly defeated BSC and won the bronze medal. Potsdam also did not spare WKK in the second match and calmly confirmed the victory of the tournament. And in the last match of the tournament, the home team, in the match against Děčín, determined who was the master in the hall already in the first half of the match and thus had no problem defending its position in the silver position.
