



NINERS Chemnitz Academy wins U17 tournament

The ninth U17 tournament took place in Ostrów Wielkopolski, Poland. The German team NINERS Chemnitz Academy performed the best and won gold medals. With a flawless record of 15:0, they secured a ticket to the final tournament.

In the first match of the tournament, the younger home team (U16) AK Ostrów 1947 plays against another Polish team PGE Giek Turów Zgorzelec . The younger players of the home team fight very bravely in a balanced match with the more experienced players of Zgorzelec, but in the end it was not enough to win. In the second match, the Czech team Basketpoint Frýdek-Místek was not enough for the Polish team TS Wisla Jura Basket . The Polish team increased its lead in the score from the beginning, which eventually grew to twenty-four points. The last team to enter the tournament is the Czech team Jižní Supi , which plays a solid game with the eventual winner NINERS Chemnitz Academy . However, the Czech team is relatively far from winning. Chemnitz came closest to defeat in the tournament in the afternoon match with Zgorzelec. The Polish team fought, but in the end the strength of Chemnitz showed and they won by nine points. The day ends with a match between the team Jižní Supi and TS Wisla Jura Basket . At first, after the first quarter, it looked like a "debacle" for the Czech team, and halfway through the match, the Polish team still held a comfortable lead. The second half was a completely different "song" from the Czech team. The Supi feasted on the Polish team like a "vulture on a carcass" and eventually won by nine points.

On Saturday, Zgorzelec showed itself in a better light when it defeated another Polish team TS Wisla Jura Basket . Which again upsets our ranking in the tournament table. In the duel of Czech teams, Basketpoint "stepped on" Jižní Supi. Basketpoint fought, pushed, but in the end it was not enough to win. In the early evening, the home team also remembered itself, trying to torment the Czech team Jižní Supi . It succeeded in this for most of the match, but it met the same fate as Basketpoint, since the last quarter belongs to Jižní Supi.

On Sunday, Chemnitz confirmed their victory in the tournament with a win over Basketpoint. In the second match, the Southern Vultures confirmed their silver medal win also thanks to a win over Zgorzelec. In the last match, the home team fought for their first win in the tournament and were the better team for at least half of the match. However, in the second half, the more experienced players of the TS Wisla Jura Basket team showed themselves and they won by eight points.
