



BSC Bratislava wins the U14 tournament

The thirteenth U14 tournament was hosted by the Czech city of Hradec Králové. The best performances were shown by the Slovak team BSC Bratislava, who won gold medals in this tournament. Thanks to their performances, they also qualified for The U14 Finals, which are hosted by the Polish city of Zielona Góra.

In the opening match of the tournament, the home team BK Gapa Hradec Králové challenged the Polish team WKK Wroclaw . The home team started actively and gained a several-point lead, which it maintained for most of the match. However, in the end, WKK "pushed the ball hard", which was only enough for a defeat by five points. In the second match, the German team NINERS Chemnitz Academy defeated the Czech team BK Opava quite calmly. The third match of the day was much more balanced. The players in this match were the Slovak team BSC Bratislava and the German team Mitteldeutscher Basketball Academy . BSC entered the match poorly and lost the entire first half of the match by a difference of around ten points. After the half-time break, a "completely different team" BSC entered, which took control of the match and led by twelve points after the third quarter. The Slovak team eventually brought the battle to a victorious end. The home team played a rather crazy match with Chemnitz. They lead by seven points after the first quarter, then lose three points at halftime and are eight points ahead after the third quarter. However, in the end, Chemnitz wins by just three points.

On Saturday, it is worth mentioning the "final duel" between BSC and Chemnitz. It must be said that BSC had the entire match relatively under control and is moving away from its German opponent point by point. At the end of the match, Chemnitz has a deficit of fifteen points. And again, the home team, they played a dramatic match with the German team Mitteldeutscher Basketball Academy . The match was like a seesaw, just like Friday's match with Chemnitz, but this time Hradec Králové matured against its opponent and won by three points. Which is the same difference in score as on Friday, but this time in favor of the Czech team.

Sunday morning offered a duel of German teams. Chemnitz fared better, confirming the silver medal with this victory. In the second match of the day, BSC Bratislava defeated the Polish team WKK Wroclaw quite calmly and won the gold medals. In the last match of the tournament, the home team BK Gapa Hradec Králové again calmly won over another Czech team BK Opava , which secured the bronze medal. The interesting thing about the tournament is that we have the two best scorers of the tournament, and even more interesting is that they are from the same team, the home team.
