



Pardubice dominated the U15 home tournament

10 very high quality and very even matches took place last weekend in Pardubice, where 5 teams from 4 countries came together. Thanks to a large turnaround at the end of the match with Vienna, the tournament was dominated by the home players.

Already during the first matches on Friday, it was clear that we had an excellent tournament with high quality in Pardubice. There were 5 teams that could really think of winning in every match and there were a number of matches that were decided only in the last minutes and sometimes seconds.

Right in the first duel, two Czech teams clashed and later it turned out that it was actually a fight for 1st place. Home Pardubice played Děčín Warriors 84:69. The second match of the tournament was actually a direct battle for medals, as in the end the third Vienna defeated the fourth Sered' with a difference of only 2 points.

One of the highlights of the tournament was undoubtedly the last match between the home team of Pardubice and Vienna, in which both teams took the lead several times and in the final minutes Pardubice managed to erase a 10-point loss and win the duel by a single basket.

This tournament was one of the highlights of this season and we are already looking forward to the next meeting in the U15 category.
